



Tips for saving money on your heating.



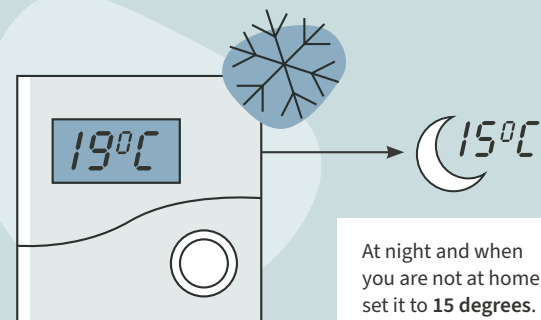

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Save on your heating costs!

In this booklet, you will find tips to cut down on your heat usage. The less heat you use, the less money you will end up paying. Follow these tips!

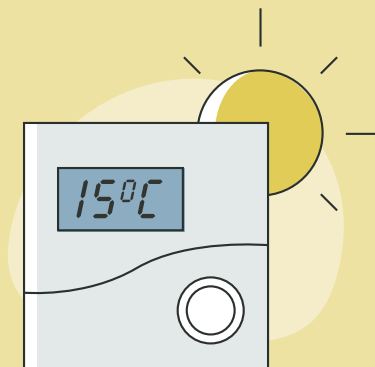
1 Saving in autumn

During **autumn and winter** (September to April), you should set the thermostat in the living room to **19 degrees**. Leave the valves on the radiators in the other rooms **open**.



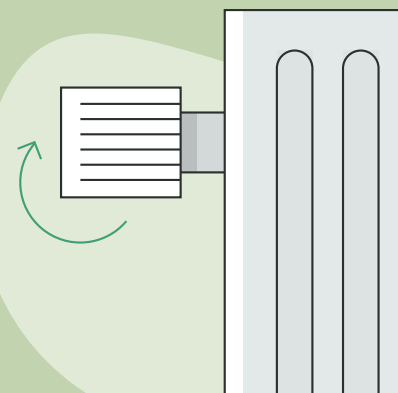
2 Saving in spring

During **spring and summer** (May to August), you should set the thermostat to **15 degrees**. Always leave the valves on the radiators in the other rooms **open**.



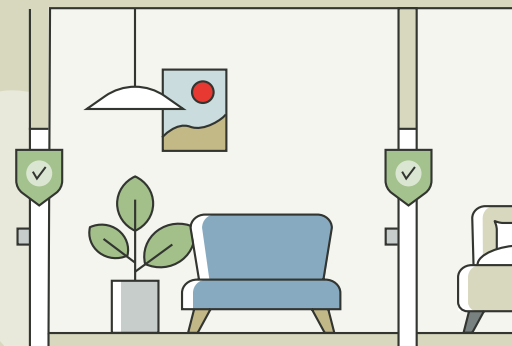
3 Turn on the valve

Turn on the open/close valve slightly in all rooms. The valves may remain **open** all year round, day and night.



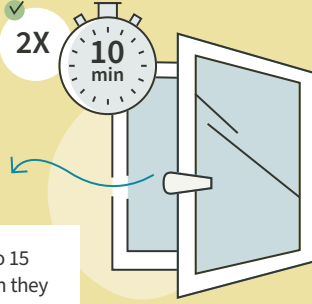
4 Keep the doors closed

Keep the **doors** from the living room to other rooms (such as the bedroom) **closed**. This will keep the living room nice and warm.



5 Open the windows twice a day

Open all windows **twice a day** for 10 minutes (in the morning and evening). Dry air heats better.

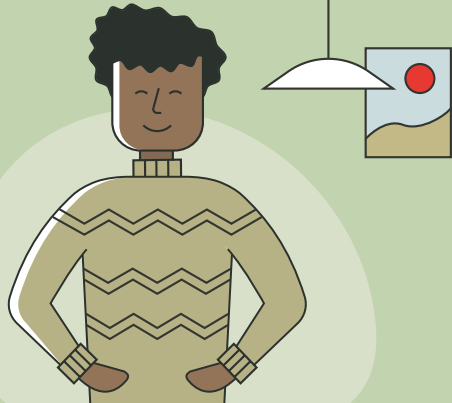


✓ **Additional tip:** Turn the thermostat back to 15 degrees while the windows are open. When they are closed again, you can turn it back to 19.

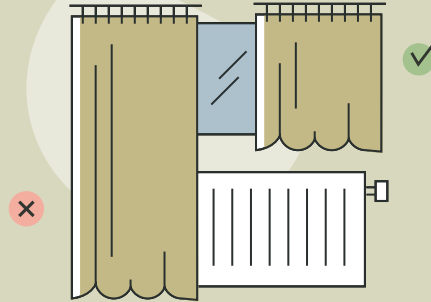
7 Put on warm clothes

Are you cold? Put on **warm clothes**. Not just in winter, but in **summer**, too!



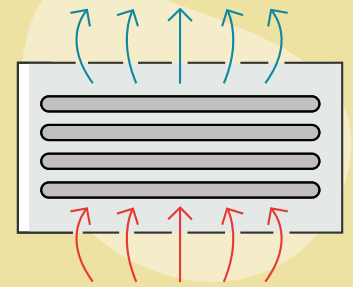
8 Nothing in front of the heater

Keep the **radiator clear** to allow the heat to circulate. Do not place **items** (such as a sofa) against the heater. Do not hang **curtains** against the heater.



9 Ventilation grilles open

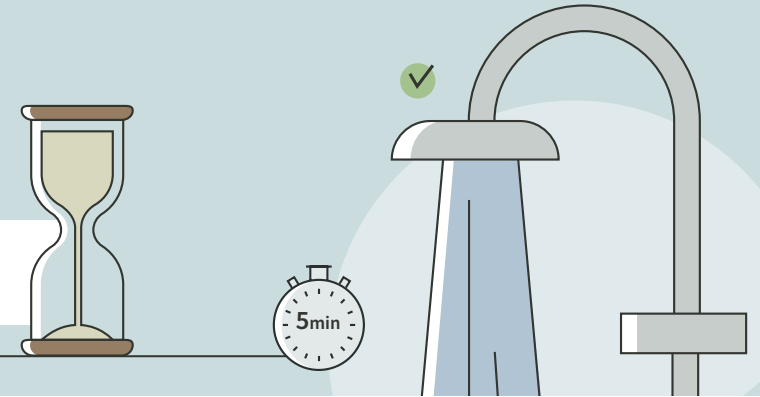
Ventilate **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**. This will ensure that you always have fresh air.



6 Take shorter showers

Shower once a day for a maximum of **five minutes**.

✓ **Additional tip:** Use an hourglass so you don't forget the time.
